New Business:

1. Parks Committee Update:

David Loggins, Parks Committee chairman was present to update the council. Loggins said there was nothing to update with the two small city parks. Mayor Jones explained that bids for work on the sportsplex should be advertised Sunday, May 19, 2024 and Sunday, May 26, 2024. Bids will be accepted until 2:00 pm on June 6, 2024. Bids will be opened for the Sports Plex at 2:00 pm on Tuesday, June 6, 2024.

Jones included that bids for work on the proposed Brookland Municipal Center should currently be open. Bid opening for the City Hall/Police Department will be at 2:00 pm on May 28, 2024 at Brookland City Hall meeting room located at 613 Holman.

2. Lion’s Club Presentation:

Roy Patterson with the Lion’s Club spoke to the council about starting a local chapter in Brookland. Patterson discussed the work Lions Clubs do for communities around the state and country. Patterson said the club will begin an advertising campaign to assess interest in starting a chapter. He explained that 20 members are needed to create a local chapter. Patterson said he will keep the council updated on the community’s response and the next steps in getting everything started.

3. ARDOT Sidewalk Project #101143 Update:

Mayor Jones addressed the council with an update regarding the ARDOT sidewalk project. Jones explained that some of the property owners wish to be paid for the sidewalk installation/right of way to use their yards. Jones said he has asked for an appraisal of the property in question and will update the council with the results of the appraisal to determine what the next steps will be.
