# 2. Kerri Annable- Ordinance 2002-16; Allowing 4-wheelers, 3-wheelers, or similar vehicles on city streets:

Kerri Annable, Brookland resident, came before the council to ask about allowing golf carts and sideby-side type vehicles on city streets. Annable encouraged the council to consider allowing and regulating the usage of these types of vehicles because of the benefits she experiences from riding with her own young child every evening. Discussion from council members included several safety issues with these types of vehicles. The council decided to table this issue and ask the Brookland Police Department to attend next month's meeting to continue the discussion and give their input.

<sup>\*</sup>Mayor Jones explained that there were some expenses in the General Fund related to repairs and maintenance for police department vehicles-Tahoe and Dodge Durango.

<sup>\*</sup>Mayor Jones informed the council that the Utility Rate Study will be conducted soon and there may be another required rate increase. Jones stated that he would update the council as needed. Jones added that the city has closed out the Municipal Building bond with Farmers & Merchants Bank. Jones reminded the council to review the Proposed 2026 budgets on their desks. Finally, Jones notified the council that they should be reimbursed soon for money used to clean out the Maple Slough ditch and, depending on when it is received, it should be included in the 2026 budgets.

Mayor Jones asked the council if they had anything to add. No comments. Jones opened the floor for any comments. There were none.
