WHEREAS, the Town of Brookland, Arkansas has constructed a Sewage Treatment Works and

WHEREAS, this treatment works was funded in part by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency requires an Industrial Cost Recovery System as a condition of its financial assistance and

WHEREAS, there are no existing industries that will discharge waste to the Municipal Sewer System

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that should the Town of Brookland, Arkansas elect to receive an industrial waste to its Sewage Treatment Works, an Industrial Cost Recovery System will be enacted in accordance with all applicable regulations of the United States Environmental Protection Agency and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an Industrial User shall be defined as any industry discharging more than 25,000 gallons per day to the Municipal Treatment Works and/or any industry which discharges any pollutant which would interfere with normal operation or efficiency of the treatment works.

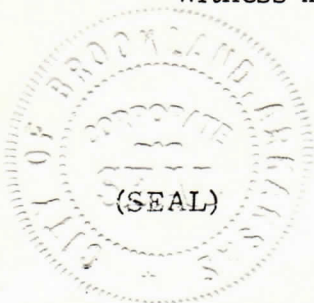

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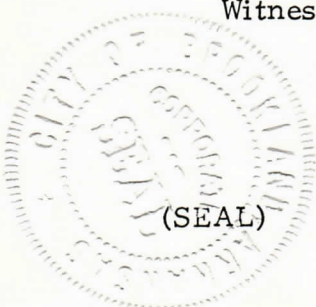
