

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-06

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID RECREATIONAL TRAILS FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City Council of Brookland, Arkansas, understands Federal-Aid Recreational Trails Funds are available at 80% federal participation and 20% local match/in kind labor to develop or improve the Maple Slough Recreational Trail, and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland, Arkansas understands that Federal-Aid Funds are available for this project on a reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual monetary reimbursement, and

WHEREAS, this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the general public and maintained by the applicant for the life of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The City of Brookland will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility, including maintenance of this project.

SECTION 2: The Mayor of the City of Brookland, Arkansas is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of the above stated project.

SECTION 3: The Brookland City Council pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department to initiate action to implement this project.
