ORDINANCE 2019-15

AN ORDINANCE TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING ON THE PURCHASE OF MINI EXCAVATOR FOR BROOKLAND UTILITIES.

WHERE AS, the City of Brookland recognizes the need to replace outdated equipment. Upgrade of current 331 Bob Cat Mini Excavator will enable Brookland Utility Department to work more efficiently while reducing maintenance cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Council of the city of Brookland, Arkansas has authorized the mayor to waive competitive bidding and advertise in a locally circulated paper according to State Statute 15-58-303 (2)(A)(I). Friday, January 31, 2020 at 4:30 p.m. end of business day for accepting sealed quotes. Will advertise in locally distributed newspaper on Sunday, January 12, 2020 and Sunday January 19, 2020.




EMERGENCY CLAUSE
