

ORDINANCE NO. 1983-2

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE NECESSITY OF ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT IN EXCESS OF \$2,000.00 (TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF BROOKLAND, CRAIGHEAD COUNTY, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS THERE IS AN IMMEDIATE NEED FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR THE TOWN OF BROOKLAND AND THE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS AND WHEREAS ACT #AS 19-4425 SEC. 5 ACT 28 OF 1959 STATES THAT ANY PURCHASE OVER \$2,000.00 (TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS) SHALL BE OPEN FOR COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WHEREAS THE TOWN COUNCIL DEEMS THIS PROCEDURE NOT FEASIBLE OR PRACTICAL THE TOWN COUNCIL HEREBY WAIVES THE NECESSITY OF ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR THE NECESSARY EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS THE TOWN HAS BEEN UNABLE TO PROVIDE DRAINAGE FOR THE CITIZENS AND THEREFORE AN EMERGENCY HAS BEEN DECLARED AND THIS ORDINANCE BEING NECESSARY FOR THE PRESERVATION OF PUBLIC PEACE HEALTH AND SAFETY, SHALL TAKE EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND PPROVAL.
