

ORDINANCE NO. 1987-10


WHEREAS, the Legislature for the State of Arkansas has provided that each County, City or Town located in said State must levy a full five mill general tax on all taxable property or suffer a portionate reduction in State aid; and

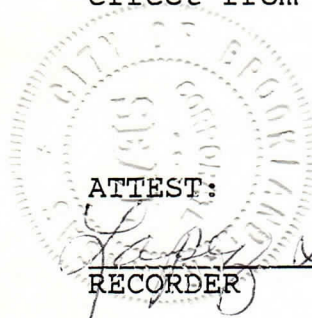
WHEREAS, the Town of Brookland is in need of State aid at least at the present levels to maintain services to its constitutents and its populous.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and established by the Town of Brookland, that:

Section 1: It is hereby ordained that the full five mill general tax is hereby levied against all taxable property within the Town of Brookland, Arkansas.

Section 2: **Emergency** - It is hereby found and determined by the Town of Brookland, Arkansas that severe reduction in funds will occur to the Town of Brookland, Arkansas in the event that this ordinance is not immediately passed and approved and made effective so that an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
