

ORDINANCE # 1988-2

WHEREAS, it is recognized by the Town Council of Brookland, Arkansas, that due to the size and growth of the Town, an orderly method of numbering the buildings should be established within the Town; Now Therefore,

Be it Ordained that:

1. The Mayor of the Town of Brookland shall establish an orderly building numbering system for the Town of Brookland.

2. The Mayor of Brookland shall assign numbers to all residences and other buildings in the Town in accordance with the numbering system instituted.

3. All owners of buildings within the limits of the Town shall prominently number all buildings owned by them with the number assigned such building within 30 days after written notification shall have been given him/her of such number assignment. Such numbering shall be placed so that it is readily readable from the street providing access to each such building.

4. All owners of buildings who fail to comply with the provisions of paragraph 3 of this Ordinance shall be considered guilty of a violation of this Ordinance and shall be subject to a fine of \$5.00 to \$50.00.

5. **Emergency Clause** - It is hereby determined that an emergency exists due to the fact that the lack of a numbering system creates serious problems when fire, ambulance or police services are needed, as the exact locations of buildings and homes within the Town are not necessarily readily determinable. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately from and after its passage.
