ORDINANCE NO. 1990-3

WHEREAS, the size and population of Brookland, Arkansas continue to grow; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to protect the populace of the town from any inadvertent negligent or intentional actions from dangerous propensities;

NOW ^{AS} THEREFORE, the town council for the Town of Brookland does hereby ^{as} follows:

1. It shall be unlawful to discharge any firearms of any type or kind within the Town of Brookland, Arkansas, except by a duly authorized law enforcement officer in the express furtherance of the performance of his lawful duties.

2. Anyone convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be assessed a fine not exceeding \$100.00.

3. It is hereby determined by the town council of Brookland, Arkansas that due to the dangerous nature of fire arms when not handled properly and the close proximity of the homes and residences of the populace of the town that it is paramount that the discharge of fire arms within the town has become a hazard and is determined to be an emergency situation so that this ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage.
