AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A STREET OR STREETS IN THE
TOWN OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, the Town of Brookland, Arkansas has hereby determined that the following street or streets have fully complied with the requirements of the Town Council to be accepted as Town streets within the limits of the Town of Brookland, Arkansas, or that the hereinafter noted conditions have been agreed upon if said Town streets do not meet the full specifications of the Town of Brookland, Arkansas,

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Town Council of Brookland, Arkansas that:

Article I: The following specifically described street is hereby accepted by the Town Council of Brookland, Arkansas as a town street and such street will be hereafter maintained in accordance with the determination of the town council and the dedicating owner is hereafter absolved from any further responsibility for maintenance of said street except as may be hereinafter noted.

Article II. The acceptance of the above mentioned street or streets is hereby conditioned upon the following:

Article III. In that the Town of Brookland, Arkansas is in need of an adequate street system and it being necessary that an orderly acceptance of the street systems within the Town of Brookland be had and maintained for adequate fire and police protection to be promptly carried out within the Town proper, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the peace, health and safety of the community is declared to be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
