

AMENDMENT TO
ORDINANCE NO. 1993-4

Weight Limits on Certain Streets

WHEREAS, certain streets within the Town of Brookland are suffering severe damage due to vehicles of excessive weight regularly traveling over them; and Ordinance No. 1993-4 was passed, but the penalty provision was inadvertently deleted;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the Town Council that:

1. Ordinance 1993-4 is amended to add the following language: Any person violating this Ordinance shall be fined the sum of not less than \$50.00, nor more than \$500.00.

2. Emergency Clause - It is hereby found by the Town Council that the streets of the Town are in need of repair, and continual travel by certain vehicles is causing serious damage thereto so that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and an emergency is declared to exist, so that this ordinance amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, passage and publication.

ORDINANCE NO. 1993-8

Weight Limits on Certain Streets

WHEREAS, certain streets within the Town of Brookland are suffering severe damage due to vehicles of excessive weight regularly traveling over them; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary by the Town Council that action be taken to alleviate the problems and help preserve the roadways of the Town;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the Town Council that:

1. The following streets within the Town of Brookland, Arkansas, are hereby declared to be closed to traffic by any motor vehicles or other vehicles weighing or having a load capacity in excess of 40,000 pounds:

2. Emergency Clause-It is hereby found by the Town Council that the streets of the Town are in need of repair, and continual travel by certain vehicles is causing serious damage thereto so that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and an emergency is declared to exist, so that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, passage and publication.
