

ORDINANCE NO. 1994-2

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PLACEMENT OF CERTAIN STOP SIGNS
WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS

Whereas, it is necessary that certain stop signs be established within the Town of Brookland to provide for orderly traffic flow and protection of the citizenry of the Town of Brookland and surrounding areas,

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Town Council of the Town of Brookland, Arkansas, that:

Article I: Stop signs are hereby established and are to be placed at the following locations:

W. School/Oak 4-WAY

Article II: In that the Town of Brookland is in need of proper traffic management and an orderly traffic flow to protect the persons and property of the community and in order to prevent automobile accidents and for other reasons an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the peace, health and safety of the community is declared to be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
