

ORDINANCE 1998-13

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PLACEMENT OF CERTAIN STOP SIGNS
WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, IT IS NECESSARY THAT CERTAIN STOP SIGNS BE
ESTABLISHED WITHIN THE CITY OF BROOKLAND TO PROVIDE FOR
ORDERLY TRAFFIC FLOW AND PROTECTION OF THE CITIZENRY OF THE
CITY OF BROOKLAND AND SURROUNDING AREAS,

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS, THAT:

ARTICLE I: STOP SIGNS ARE HEREBY ESTABLISHED AND ARE TO
BE PLACED AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

WHITE OAK & PECAN
JESSICA & HWY. 49 N.
JODY & JESSICA
MARGIE & TERESA
MARGIE & JANIS
DARR & S. OAK

ARTICLE II. IN THAT THE CITY OF BROOKLAND IS IN NEED OF
PROPER TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AND AN ORDERLY TRAFFIC FLOW TO
PROTECT THE PERSONS AND PROPERTY OF THE COMMUNITY AND IN
ORDER TO PREVENT AUTOMOBILE ACCIDENTS AND FOR OTHER REASONS
AN EMERGENCY IS DECLARED TO EXIST AND THIS ORDINANCE BEING
NECESSARY FOR THE PEACE, HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE COMMUNITY IS
DECLARED TO BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS
PASSAGE.
