

ORDINANCE NO. 2000- 5

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that an ordinance is needed to deal with circumstances regarding the orderly regulation of traffic upon the streets, alleys, private property and highways within the Town of Brookland.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED THAT:

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to drive any motor vehicle upon the public way or upon any private driveway within the Town of Brookland, Arkansas, in an inattentive manner.
- (b) An inattentive manner of driving is defined as the operation of any motor vehicle on the public way or private way of the Town of Brookland, Arkansas, while failing to give reasonable regard or attention to the act of driving or operation of such vehicle.
- (c) Any person adjudged guilty of violation of this section shall, upon conviction, be fined in the amount of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- (d) **Emergency Clause.** Due to the immediate need for alternative traffic enforcement procedures, and in the interest of the health and safety of the citizenry of Brookland, Arkansas, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
