ORDINANCE NO. 2006-2

ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1990-3 to include the exclusion for a NRA certified indoor firing range.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to protect the populace of the City of Brookland, Arkansas from inadvertent negligent or intentional actions from dangerous propensities;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1990-3 was enacted to make it unlawful to discharge firearms of any type or kind within the City of Brookland, Arkansas, except by a duly authorized law enforcement officer in the express furtherance of the performance of his or her lawful duties.


WHEREAS, as request has been made to construct a NRA certified indoor firing range in the City of Brookland, Arkansas.


NOW THEREFORE, the City Council for the City of Brookland, Arkansas does hereby ordain as follows:

1. There shall be a further exception to Ordinance No. 1990-3, whereby Ordinance No. 1990-3 shall not apply to anyone discharging firearms of any type or kind within the City of Brookland, Arkansas if such discharge takes place in a National Rifle Association certified indoor firing range.
2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE: That the City of Brookland, Arkansas determines that there is an immediate need for the exclusion to Ordinance No. 1990-3 as stated above so that construction can promptly begin on the construction of the National Rifle Association certified indoor firing range, and it constitutes an emergency. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force in and after its passage.
