ORDINANCE 2006-4

AND ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2003-3 BETTER KNOWN AS THE PLANNING AND ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS ESTABLISHING THE METHOD OF APPOINTMENT AND LENGTH OF TERM, OF APPOINTMENTS TO THE COMMISSION.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Brookland, Arkansas that Ordinance 2003-3 needs to be amended to include the following:


The City Council shall create a planning commission of not less than five (5) members, of whom at least two-thirds (2/3) shall not hold any other municipal office or appointment except membership in the board of adjustment or a joint planning agency.


The terms of office of the Chairperson shall be three (3) years, the Vice Chairperson shall be two (2) years and other officers shall be one year, or until a successor is appointed, whichever shall last occur. Robert's Rules of Order shall give the operations and procedures of the City of Brookland Planning Commission.

Any Commission member who resigns or who shall fail to attend three (3) consecutive regular meetings of the Commission shall be considered to have vacated his/her appointment to the Commission. Subsequent to the vacancy, the Mayor shall appoint a member to the commission.

Emergency Clause: The City of Brookland, Arkansas determines there is an immediate need for the passage of Ordinance 2006-4 to insure proper and timely appointments to the Planning Commission. Therefore, an emergency is declared and this ordinance shall be in full force, in and after its passage.
