ORDINANCE NO. 2010-04

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of Brookland Arkansas, that there has been problems within the city with regard to certain streets so that limits on the speeds traveled on said streets by motor vehicles is necessary for the public benefit and good; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that an ordinance be established to set such speed limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained that:

1. The maximum speeds allowable on the streets noted hereafter shall be as indicated:  
Church Street (between W. Hinkley and W. Matthews.....maximum speed 20 mph  
Church Street (between W. Hinkley and Stevens.....maximum speed 10 mph
2. Any person violating the above ordinance shall be fined the sum of not less than \$25.00, or more than \$100.00.
3. Emergency Clause. It being necessary that the health, welfare and well being of the citizenry of the City of Brookland are of paramount importance to the City Council of Brookland, Arkansas, and any injury or damage to any person or property within the city are hereby declared to constitute an emergency so that in order that the peace, welfare and well being of the community may be sustained it is hereby declared that an emergency exists with regard to this ordinance and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
