 ORDINANCE NO. 2012-18

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2009-17 TO MODIFY THE WATER RATE STRUCTURE FOR BROOKLAND UTILITIES TO INCLUDE A MULTI-FAMILY COMPLEX RATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland, Arkansas SHALL pass an ordinance amending Ordinance 2009-17 to add Section 4 authorizing Brookland Utilities water rate structure to include a multi family complex rate. Multi family complex rate shall be used for a single water meter connection.

WHEREAS, the Brookland City Council may evaluate the Brookland Utilities Budget annually to adjust water rates as may be required in the future to meet the necessary obligations of Brookland Utilities Water Systems;

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Brookland does hereby ordain that Ordinance 2009-17 shall be amended to add the following:

Section 4. City monthly water rate schedule for a multi family complex shall be as follows:

First 1,000 gallons for ¾"- 1" duplex.....	\$16.29(minimum)
First 1,000 gallons for 1 ½" triplex	\$22.31(minimum)
First 1,000 gallons for 2" quadplex.....	\$28.33(minimum)
First 1,000 gallons for 2" sixteen apartment complex.....	\$100.50(minimum)
First 1,000 gallons for any complex containing more than 4 units and less than 16 units shall include an additional amount of \$5.75 per unit.	
Next 4,000 gallons.....	\$4.25 per 1,000 gallons
All over 5,000 gallons.....	\$1.25 per 1,000 gallons

Emergency clause. It is hereby determined by the City Council of Brookland, Arkansas that the need for funding for capital improvement projects and maintenance of the current water system is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the populace of Brookland, Arkansas; and further if the maintenance projects are not completed forthwith then it may be extremely costly for the City of Brookland, Arkansas, due to the failure to meet certain ADH and ADEQ standards, it is therefore declared by the City Council that an emergency exists with regard to the passage of this rate schedule increase and this ordinance shall be in effect from the date of its passage.
