City of Brookland
Ordinance No. 2013-17

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of Brookland, Arkansas, that there is problems with school traffic on certain streets so that limits of direction of travel on said streets is necessary for the public benefit and safety; and


WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that an ordinance be established to set such direction and times;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained that:

1. West School Street shall be one-way starting at U.S. Highway 49-B traveling west to North Bernis Street during the hours of 7:15 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and from 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. during the days the Brookland Public Schools are in session.
2. North Bernis Street shall be one-way starting at West School Street running south to north entrance of Oak Meadow Circle during the hours of 7:15 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and from 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. during the days the Brookland Public Schools are in session.
3. Any person violating the above ordinance shall be fined the sum of not less than \$50.00, nor more than \$150.00

Emergency Clause. It being necessary to protect the safety of children transported to Brookland Public Schools by motor vehicle, and the safety of traffic on U.S. Highway 49, due to the large volume of motor vehicles traveling east on West School Street that are impeding the flow of traffic and causing vehicles to back up at the intersection U.S. Highway 49 within the city limits of Brookland, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage this August 19, 2013.
