ORDINANCE NO. 2013-24

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of Brookland Arkansas, that annexed county roads shall be given city street names and that limits on the speeds traveled on said streets by motor vehicles is necessary for public safety, benefit and good; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that an ordinance be established to name annexed county roads and set such speed limits and city street names;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained that:


1. The annexed county roads shall be named and maximum speeds allowable on the streets noted hereafter shall be as indicated:
 - A. CR 736 to Nelda Lane, Speed Limit max at 20 MPH
 - B. CR 738 to Brady Lane, Speed Limit max at 20 MPH
 - C. CR 733 to Keith Road, Speed Limit max at 20 MPH
 - D. CR 735 to Manley Lane, Speed Limit max at 20 MPH
 - E. CR 937, Speed Limit max at 30 MPH
 - F. CR 706 to Egg Farm Road, Speed Limit max at 30 MPH
 - G. CR768 to Hudson Lane, Speed Limit max at 30 MPH
 - H. CR 935 to Davidson Lane, Speed Limit max at 30 MPH
 - I. CR 942 to Everett Bolton Lane, Speed Limit max at 30 MPH
 - J. CR 741 to Whitten Creek Road, Speed Limit max at 35 MPH
 - K. CR 739 to North Oak Street, Speed Limit max at 35 MPH; beginning at 325 North Oak, north to CR 762
 - L. CR 936 to East School Street, Speed Limit max at 40 MPH
 - M. CR 928 to Three Notch Road, Speed Limit max at 45 MPH
2. Any person violating the above ordinance shall be fined the sum of not less than \$25.00, nor more than \$100.00.
3. **Emergency Clause.** It being necessary for 911 addresses in Brookland city limits to be correctly identified to allow emergency personnel to respond in a timely manner, the health, welfare and well being of the citizens of the City of Brookland are of paramount importance to the City Council of Brookland, Arkansas. Any injury or damage, due to improper addressing, to any person or property within the city are hereby declared to constitute an emergency so that in order that the peace, welfare and well being of the community may be

sustained it is hereby declared that an emergency exists with regard to this ordinance and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
