**ORDINANCE NO. 2014-07**

**AN ORDINANCE TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING ON THE ASBESTOS ABATMENT PROCESS OF DEBRIS REMOVAL AT 403 AND 405 HOLMAN**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brookland recognizes the need to hire a contractor to remove and dispose of asbestos and lead paint contaminated debris located at 403 and 405 Holman. The contaminated debris needs to be removed and disposed of in accordance with ADEQ asbestos abatement regulations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**


The Council of the City of Brookland, Arkansas has authorized the Mayor to waive competitive bidding and advertise in a locally circulated news paper according to State Statute 14-58-303 (2) (A) (i). Selected bidder shall haul debris from 403 and 405 Holman to Legacy Landfill according to guidance by the certified asbestos abatement company contracted by the City of Brookland to oversee the project. Competitive bids will be accepted at Brookland City Hall April 21, 2014 through April 25, 2014 until 10:00 am at which time bids will be opened in the community room located at 613 Holman. Selected bidder shall present proof of insurances; liability, workers comp, as required by the State of Arkansas.


**Emergency Clause**

The City Council of Brookland, Arkansas determines that there is a serious safety risk of personal injury to the populace of citizens Brookland because of debris from the collapse and demolition at 403 and 405 Holman. The debris contains friable asbestos and creates a health and safety issue for the citizens of Brookland. Therefore an emergency exists and this ordinance shall be in effect from the date of its passage by the Brookland City Council.
