**ORDINANCE NO. 2016-24**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-31 SETTING SPEED LIMITS FOR CITY STREETS IN THE BROOKLAND HILLS SUBDIVISION.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brookland, Arkansas (the "City"), previously passed Ordinance No. 2015-31 regarding the speed limits of certain city streets in the Brookland Hills Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, certain streets have been added to the Brookland Hills Subdivision due to expansion;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brookland wishes to have a uniform speed limit for all streets in the Brookland Hills Subdivision;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brookland wishes to lower the speed limit on the city streets in the Brookland Hills Subdivision to fifteen miles per hour (15 mph); and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Brookland, Arkansas;


Section 1. The maximum speeds allowable on the streets noted hereafter in the Brookland Hills Subdivision shall be as indicated:



| a. Clark Cove   | maximum speed 15 mph |
| b. Clark Drive  | maximum speed 15 mph |
| c. Emma Drive   | maximum speed 15 mph |
| d. Harper Drive | maximum speed 15 mph |
| e. Sloan Circle | maximum speed 15 mph |
| f. Sloan Drive  | maximum speed 15 mph |
| g. Sophie Drive | maximum speed 15 mph |

Section 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby ascertained and declared that there is a great need to lower the speed limit on the city streets located in the Brookland Hills Subdivision and in addition establish the speed limits on new streets located therein in order to promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of the City and its inhabitants. It is, therefore, declared that an emergency exists and this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety shall be in force and take effect immediately from and after its passage.
