RESOLUTION NO. 2008-01

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MULTI-JURISDICTION NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN, CRAIGHEAD COUNTY, ARKANSAS BY THE CITY OF BROOKLAND**

**WHEREAS**, certain areas of Craighead County, Arkansas are subject to periodic flooding and other natural and man-caused hazards with the potential to cause damages to people's properties within the area; and

**WHEREAS**, Craighead County and the Plan Participants desire to prepare and mitigate for such circumstances; and

**WHEREAS**, under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Congress required that local jurisdictions have in place a Federal Emergency Management Agency-approved Natural Mitigation Plan as a condition of receipt of certain future Federal mitigation funding after November 1, 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, to assist local jurisdictions in meeting this requirement, Craighead County, with the assistance of a private contractor, Geofemme, initiated development of the Multi-Jurisdiction Natural Mitigation Plan, Craighead County, Arkansas, covering unincorporated Craighead County, ten incorporated areas, and twelve school districts;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BROOKLAND, CRAIGHEAD COUNTY, ARKANSAS:**

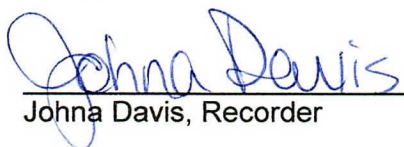
That Brookland, Craighead County, Arkansas hereby adopts those portions of the Plan entitled *Multi-Jurisdiction Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan, Craighead County, Arkansas*: Protecting Brookland, Craighead County against all hazards, 2007-2012 that pertain to Brookland, Craighead County; and

Appoints the County Office of Emergency Management coordinator to assure that the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan be reviewed at least annually and that any needed adjustment to Craighead County's addendum to the Hazard Mitigation Plan be developed and presented to this Council for consideration; and

Agrees to take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.
