Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Brookland, State of Arkansas a resolution entitled: Maple Slough Fishing Area.

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor of Brookland to apply for a grant on behalf of the City of Brookland.

Whereas, the Brookland City Council has determined that the City of Brookland meets eligibility requirements necessary to apply for a grant under the Wildlife Recreation Facilities Grant; and

Whereas, the City of Brookland has presented plans to construct a parking area, an access trail and a fishing area on Maple Slough for public use; and

Whereas, the City Council of Brookland recognizes the need for the project, concurs its importance, and supports the City of Brookland in its efforts to proceed with the same; and

Therefore, be it resolved, that the Mayor of Brookland is hereby authorized to submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Rural Development Commission for purposes of securing state grant funds in the amount of \$99,000.00 to aid and assist the City of Brookland in executing the proposed project described herein and that the Mayor or Recorder/Treasurer of the City of Brookland is further authorized to administer the grant funds for the same project.
