RESOLUTION NO. 2011-17
A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FUTURE LAND USE PLAN MAP
FOR THE CITY OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, cities of first and second class and incorporated towns have the power to adopt and enforce plans for the coordinated, adjusted, and harmonious development of the municipality and its environs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brookland, Arkansas wishes to adopt a Future Land Use Plan Map to amend the Brookland General Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has appointed a Planning Commission and the Planning Commission has undertaken the following:

- (1) Prepared a work program;
- (2) Prepared a Planning Area Map;
- (3) Made studies of the present conditions and the probable future growth of the municipality and its neighboring territory;
- (4) Prepared a General Development Plan for the city's planning area; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a duly advertised Public Hearing on November 8th, 2011, to allow discussion and citizen comments on the proposed document; and


WHEREAS, the Planning Commission adopted the plan and has forwarded it to the City Council for certification.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS, THAT:

1. The Future Land Use Plan Map is hereby adopted to amend the Brookland General Development Plan.
2. The City Clerk is directed to maintain a copy of the plan in her office for public review.
